



RACE DAY ADVISORIES!!!

As a courtesy to our residents and businesses, the City of Sausalito, the Sausalito Chamber of Commerce and the Tour of California local organizing committee want our friends and neighbors to know about the following traffic, road and parking advisories in conjunction with the **Amgen Tour of California**.

On Monday, February 16 The VIP Race starts at 8 am and the Pro race starts at 8:30 am from downtown Sausalito in front of the Spinnaker Restaurant and Gabrielson Park. The VIP riders will head straight up to Vista Point and the pro cyclists will make two parade loops down Bridgeway to Caledonia and then head south over the Golden Gate Bridge—the first time ever that a bike race has crossed the Bridge. It will not be possible to watch the racers start in downtown Sausalito and also see them cross the bridge. **Choose one location to watch the race or the other.**

*****ROAD CLOSURES*****

- Alexander Ave to the Bridge will be closed to ALL vehicular traffic from 6-10 am.
- Bridgeway (from Napa St. south), Richardson St. (between Bridgeway and Second St.), Second St. and South St. will be closed from 7:30-8:45 am.
- Caledonia **will be closed with no cross traffic allowed** EXCEPT ON NAPA St. from 8:15-9:30 am.
- Both Vista Point and the Northwest side parking lot off Conzelman Rd. will be closed from midnight -10:30am.

*****PARKING*****

- No Parking “Tow Away” zones on Monday, Feb. 16 from 12:30-9:30 am, -- Caledonia St., Bridgeway (south of Napa St.), Second St., Alexander, or Parking Lot #3, and the Pay-Per Space parking lot #2 located beside the Bank of America..
- Cars may remain parked on South St. but will be unable to move from 7:45-8:45 am.
- Sausalito lot 1 will be open, lots 2 & 3 will be closed for the race, however the Dunphy Park parking lot will be open for **free parking**.
