



As a courtesy to our residents and businesses, the City of Sausalito, the Sausalito Chamber of Commerce and the Amgen Tour of California local organizing committee want you to know about the following traffic, road and parking advisories in conjunction with Race Weekend:

Road closures:

On **Monday, February 18**, access within the city limits will be subject to minor delays prior to, during and shortly after the race start. Northbound Bridgeway will be closed at the intersection of Princess Street at 10:45 am, re-opening at approximately 11:30 am. Southbound Bridgeway will be closed at the intersection of Easterby Street during the same time frame. All side streets that access Caledonia will also be closed to through traffic during this time, as will all side streets that access northbound Bridgeway between the intersections of Princess and Gate 5 Road.

Best Places to Watch the Race:

The Race will start on Spinnaker Drive and the cyclists will ride through town and down Caledonia Street making three parade loops for spectators before heading north on Bridgeway to tackle the coastal highway. The center of town and north on Bridgeway, as well as Caledonia Street will be great places to watch the race.

Parking:

Municipal Parking Lots 2 & 3 will be closed and inaccessible until after the race (approximately 12 pm); Parking Lot 1 will be open.

Pets:

Protect your dog! Leave your favorite Fido at home or leashed and under control. Valet bicycle parking will be provided.

Last year's race operations were flawless. This year, over 150 law enforcement and public safety officials will be in Sausalito Race Day to ensure that once again the race respects residents and merchants with minimal disruption.
